# **NEW FOR 2024**

### Requirements to lease a 2024 GHCA Boat Ramp Key

- 1. Proof of ownership in Gulf Harbors or long-term rental (must show a lease with 6 months+ remaining on it from the date you apply to lease the key.)
- 2. A current 2024 GHCA membership card.
- 3. A current picture ID (driver's license, passport, government issued ID, or military ID)
- 4. You must be 21 years of age or older.
- A completed and signed Boat Ramp Key Holder Acceptance of Rules and Regulations and the Release and Waiver of Liability form.
- The return of your leased 2023 GHCA Boat Ramp Key, if applicable (failure to return last year's key may result in a \$100 fine plus the security deposit and lease fee for the current year).
- 7. Contractors must supply a Certificate of Insurance.
- 8. The corresponding fee(s) paid (see below).

### <u> 2024 FEES</u>

1. Security Deposit: \$10.00. This is applicable to all GHCA Boat Ramp Key applicants.

Upon return of your previously leased GHCA Boat Ramp Key, the prior year's security deposit will be used towards the current year's GHCA Boat Ramp Key lease.

2. Boat Ramp Key Lease Fees:

A. Homeowner/Long Term Renter: \$ 40.00 B. Homeowner/Contractor: \$500.00

C. Homeowner Advertising on

AirBNB or VRBO: \$500.00

D. Non-homeowner/Contractor: \$750.00

E. Homeowner/Long Term

Renter: One-time Ramp Opening: \$100.00

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


# Calusa Cruise Club

### Proper Pet Waste Disposal


Pasco County is asking pet owners to do their part by collecting their pet's waste and properly disposing of it.

When pet waste is left on the ground, stormwater runoff carries the bacteria and nutrients into waterways. This waste runoff contributes to algae blooms and unhealthy conditions for fish and wildlife. Polluted waters are also unsafe for swimming and recreation.

Keep Pasco County's waterways clean by disposing of your pet waste in the trash. Violations can result in a \$150 fine.

## **Spicy Fish Soup**

Happy New Year! After the holidays we all try to eat healthier and this is a delicious choice low in calories but yet very filling and perfect during our colder months.

Prep: 15 minutes cook: 17 minutes serves: 6

3 garlic cloves crushed

1 celery branch chopped

1 carrot chopped

2 Yukon gold potatoes chopped in ½ inch cubes

1 jalapeño chopped seeds removed

½ cup red bell pepper chopped

1/4 cup cilantro chopped

1 tomato chopped

½ teaspoon salt & pepper

1 ½ cup chicken broth

3 cup fish broth or seafood broth

3 tablespoons Goya Sorito tomato cooking base

1 lb white fish (any) chopped in 1 ½ inch cubes (I used white grunts)

1 lb mussels

6 (3oz) grouper pieces

1 tablespoon Old bay seasoning

1 teaspoon Sea salt

2 tablespoon olive oil

Grated Parmesan cheese

Crusty whole grain garlic bread toasted

In a large pot set on medium high heat add first 10 ingredients. Bring to a boil and cook 5 minutes. Next add fish broth, tomato base, white fish and mussels. Bring back to a soft boil and cook an additional 7 minutes or until mussels have opened discard any mussels that have not opened.

Next season the grouper pieces with old bay seasoning and sea salt. In a frying pan heat the oil on medium high heat, add the fish and cook for 4 minutes turn and cook an additional 4 minutes. Serve soup in bowls sprinkle with parmesan cheese and top with a grouper piece. Serve with crusty garlic bread. Bon Appétit

# The Boater's Corner By Captains Bruce and Wendy Longman

#### **HAPPY NEW YEAR!!**

With the passing of another year comes....you guessed it...Resolutions! Have you made a resolution to get out and do more boating this year? Promise to take a little more time for yourself, family and friends on the sandbar? We're so fortunate to live in a place with year round boating. Do you have a "Honey Do" list for your boat? If not, now is the time to take stock in your boat inventory to ensure all is ship shape. Let's start with pulling off the engine covers and spray the entire engine with anti-corrosion spray.

Check to make sure you have visual distress signals that meet both day and night use. To see specifically what's required for your length and type of vessel, visit:

https://myfwc.com/boating/safety-education/equipment/. Check the date code on flares to see they haven't expired. If they have expired, separate them from unexpired flares and keep them as back ups for an emergency. You can also put them in the trunk of your car in case of a road side emergency as well. Please dispose of expired flares properly. Coast Guard Auxiliary will generally take them for training exercises. You can also call West Marine or the Fire Department. Flares that have been ignited and fully extinguished may be thrown in household trash.

Speaking of extinguished have you checked the gauges on your fire extinguisher lately? Don't forget to turn them upside down and shake it up to loosen up the powder.

How's that horn? It's always a good idea to have a back up because horns (like fuel gauges) have a notoriously short life span. Something as simple as a whistle will legally suffice. Air horns are a great back up, however, only if it's full!!

How are your life jackets? If there are tears, ripped seams, wear spots or mildew it's time to invest in some new ones. By law, if a life jacket or throwable has a rip or tear, it is rendered useless by the USCG. You would (at the very least) get a warning if not a fine.

First aid kits also have expiration dates on certain contents so keep an eye on them. Is yours refilled and fully stocked after it was used last summer? You don't need the kitchen sink in your kit, but a well equipped kit means the difference between a great day on the water or coming in early.

This is just the tip of the proverbial iceberg. There's bilges, spare fuses and bulbs, spare docklines, checking the anchor rode, stanchions, hardware and the list goes on and on and on.

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
