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What is a LSV converted golf cart?

Section 320.01(41), Florida Statutes, defines LSVs as "any fourwheeled vehicle whose top speed is greater than 20 miles per hour, but not greater than 25 miles per hour." LSVs must be registered, titled and insured with personal injury protection (PIP) and property damage liability (PDL) insurance. Any person operating an LSV must have a valid driver license in their immediate possession.

LSVs may be operated only on streets where the posted speed limit is 35 MPH or less and must be equipped with the following safety equipment: Headlamps, front and rear turn signals, stop lamps, tail lamps, reflex reflectors, red – one each side and one on the rear, exterior mirror on the driver side and an interior rearview mirror or exterior mirror on the passenger side, parking brake, DOT compliant windshield, seat belt for each designated seat, and a vehicle identification number (VIN).

Boat Ramp Rules

The two boat ramps in Gulf Harbors are owned by the Gulf Harbors Civic Association and maintained for the benefit of our membership.

The <u>North Channel Ramp</u>, off Bowline Bend, has a steep incline and is suitable for all size boats. <u>Recommended use at High Tide</u>.

The South Channel Ramp near the intersection of Floramar Terrace and Topsail Trail can always be used, but it is <u>better suited for use at Mid to High Tide</u>.

To schedule a ramp opening, contact one of the following Official Key Holders. They are volunteers. Please give them a minimum of 1 HOUR notice. You can call, or text them for easier contact.

PLEASE NOTE: The best time to launch boats from the South Channel boat ramp is between HALF and HIGH TIDE.

The following regulations apply to all ramp users:

- 1. Use is **<u>Restricted to Daylight</u>** hours only.
- 2. A current GHCA membership card must be presented to gain access along with boat registration in the cardholder's name and current driver's license. **Must be 21 years of age or older.**

NO EXCEPTIONS!!

- 3. Non-members will be charged \$100.00 (in advance) for each opening of the ramp.
- 4. Do not use your engines to load or unload boats.
- Bring your own helpers. It is not the responsibility of the key holders to assist you in launching or retrieving your boat.
- If you intend to use the boat ramp frequently, a key may be leased from the GHCA Office for your personal use. Keys are \$40.00 plus a \$10.00 security deposit (GHCA members only). Please inquire at the GHCA Office for the requirements to lease a key. The leased key is only to be used by the authorized GHCA member.
- 7. Ramp locks are changed January 5th of each year.
- Please report any misuse of the boat ramps to the GHCA Office or the Boat Ramp Supervisor, Frank Rose at 401-447-0996.

Announcements

- 1. All canals are a NO WAKE ZONE!!! Slow down to protect the manatees, turtles, etc. and everyone's water crafts, seawalls and property!!
- 2. The boat ramp locks are changed the beginning of every January. The 2024 boat ramp keys will be available in the Office for lease mid-December.



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From the Desk of Public Relations

Several Florida state laws took effect on October 1, and one of them affects the use of golf carts. The law now states that any driver of a golf cart under the age of 18 must have a valid driver's license or learner's permit. If you are 18 or over, only an ID is needed.

This also brings up the issue of safe driving practices. Not too long ago there was a terrible accident involving a golf cart near the corner of Topsail and Floramar. There is a 3way stop at that corner, but there are many instances of drivers running the stop sign. The location of the boat ramp there makes it even more important to pay attention. Some drivers are dangerously crossing into the lane of oncoming traffic to get past vehicles loading or unloading their boats. Please pay particular attention at that corner; we don't need to make avoidable contributions to the Sherriff's department.

And speaking of the boat ramp, there are still some GHCA members loaning out their boat ramp keys. There is a good reason why this is not allowed, and can result in the loss of your use of the boat ramp. The GHCA pays for the upkeep of the boat ramps, and some of that cost is covered by the charge for the keys. When you loan your key, not only does it cause a direct loss of revenue, but it puts more wear and tear on the facilities that GHCA has to maintain. So we all end up paying for those that get the key for free.

We have a lot of new people in the neighborhood, so first let me say that you made a wise choice, this is a great community. And to keep it great, there are a few basic things to keep in mind, which include:

1. County ordinances do not allow parking of trailers, motor homes, or other recreational vehicles in front of your house, but you can have an RV parked for no more than 3 days to allow for cleaning and loading;

2. Our deed restrictions for most areas also do not allow storing of recreational vehicles or trailers on the side of the house. There are multiple deed restrictions for different areas, and the GHCA website has instructions on how to find the ones that apply to your particular house;

3. The speed limit is 30 MPH. That is not a suggestion!4. Golf carts are allowed in our community, but refer to the first paragraph above;

5. Above all, be considerate of your neighbors.





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The Boater's Corner By Captains Bruce and Wendy Longman

SALVAGE LAW: Do You Get to Keep an Abandoned Boat?

Salvage law is very old and dates back to medieval times, when men went to sea primarily to engage in commerce. A vessel in trouble often carried cargo worth as much or more than the ship itself, and the men attracted by her distress were just as likely to plunder her as to save her. Thus the core principle of salvage law has always been that honest men who risk their own lives and vessels trying to save other vessels should be very well rewarded.

Under current U.S. admiralty law, which conforms to international salvage law as laid out in the Salvage Convention of 1989, assistance rendered another vessel is considered salvage when: 1) the assisted vessel is subject to a reasonable apprehension of marine peril; 2) the assistance is voluntary; and 3) the assistance is successful in whole or part.

A successful salvor is NOT entitled to just keep the salved vessel, under any circumstances, but is entitled to a generous award. The amount of the award, under the law, is based on the following factors: 1) the value of the vessel and its contents after the salvage is complete; 2) the salvor's skill and initiative in minimizing damage to the environment; 3) the degree of success obtained by the salvor; 4) the level of peril to which the salvaged vessel was subject; 5) the salvor's skill and initiative in saving the vessel, human lives, and other property; 6) the salvor's labor and expenses; 7) the amount of risk run by the salvor; 8) the promptness of the services rendered; 9) the availability and use of any alternative salvage resources; and 10) the readiness, efficiency, and value of the salvor's vessel and equipment.

Consider all these factors together, and you'll note they strongly favor the salvor. The idea being that salvors should not only be compensated for their time and trouble; they should also receive a substantial premium as an inducement to render assistance in the first place.

So if you do find an abandoned boat floating around and tow it to safety, you don't automatically own it, but you can withhold the boat from the owner until you have received reasonable compensation for your time, skill and effort.

On the other hand, if you remove equipment or anything at all from a abandoned boat this is against the law and you could be charged with theft.

Spinach Artichoke Dip Macaroni and Cheese

½ pound elbow pasta
10 oz. fresh spinach chopped
1 tablespoon extra-virgin olive oil
2 tablespoon butter
2 tablespoon flour
1 ½ cup milk
Pinch salt & pepper
2 garlic cloves minced
4 oz. cream cheese
½ cup parmesan cheese
½ cup sour cream
½ cup sour cream
¼ cup mayonnaise
14 oz. can artichoke hearts drained and chopped
1 teaspoon red pepper flakes

Topping-1 ¼ cup buttery crackers crushed ¼ cup parmesan cheese ¼ cup melted butter

Preheat oven at 350 degrees. Spray with non-stick cooking spray a 9 x9 baking dish set aside.

Cook elbow pasta according the package instructions.

In an non-stick pan on medium high heat add olive oil and spinach sauté until completely welted and set aside.

In a sauce pan on medium heat melt butter add flour and whisk about 1 minute add milk and continue to whisk until it thickens add a pinch of salt and pepper. To the white sauce add garlic, cream cheese, ½ cup parmesan cheese, mozzarella cheese whisk until the cheese is melted into the white sauce. To the sauce add sour cream, mayonnaise, cooked spinach, red pepper flakes and chopped artichoke hearts.

Pour sauce over elbow macaroni and mix until well incorporated.

In a small bowl mix crush crackers, parmesan cheese and melted butter until well combined.

Pour your macaroni and cheese into the grease casserole and top with buttery cracker mixture.

Bake 30 minutes until nice and bubbly and top is golden in color.

Let sit 10 minutes.
