



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Boat Ramp Rules

The two boat ramps in Gulf Harbors are owned by the Gulf Harbors Civic Association and maintained for the benefit of our membership.

The <u>North Channel Ramp</u>, off Bowline Bend, has a steep incline and is suitable for all size boats. **Recommended use at High Tide**.

The South Channel Ramp near the intersection of Floramar Terrace and Topsail Trail can always be used, but it is <u>better suited for use at Mid to High Tide</u>.

To schedule a ramp opening, contact one of the following Official Key Holders. They are volunteers. Please give them a minimum of 1 HOUR notice. You can call, or text them for easier contact.

PLEASE NOTE: The best time to launch boats from the South Channel boat ramp is between HALF and HIGH TIDE.

The following regulations apply to all ramp users:

- Use is Restricted to Daylight hours only.
- A current GHCA membership card must be presented to gain access along with boat registration in the cardholder's name and current driver's license. Must be 21 years of age or older.

NO EXCEPTIONS!!

- Non-members will be charged \$100.00 (in advance) for each opening of the ramp.
- Do not use your engines to load or unload boats.
- Bring your own helpers. It is not the responsibility of the key holders to assist you in launching or retrieving your boat.
- If you intend to use the boat ramp frequently, a key
 may be leased from the GHCA Office for your
 personal use. Keys are \$40.00 plus a \$10.00 security
 deposit (GHCA members only). Please inquire at the
 GHCA Office for the requirements to lease a key.

The leased key is only to be used by the authorized GHCA member.

- Ramp locks are changed January 5th of each year.
- Please report any misuse of the boat ramps to the GHCA Office or the Boat Ramp Supervisor, Frank Rose at 401-447-0996.

This is where a bad actor files a false document showing that they own your property, and then they can take out a mortgage, all without your knowledge. Pasco County has set up a system where you can register your property, at no charge, and be notified if there are any filings against it. This notification would allow you to take action immediately. You can register at the Pasco County Clerk website, or go directly to https://www.propertyfraudalert.com/FLPasco.

Recent rains require more frequent grass mowing. When you take care of your lawn, please pay attention to the front curb. Sometimes the front is not edged completely and the grass can grow past the lawn and into the street. Not only can this obstruct street drainage, but it is unattractive and detracts for the clean look we want in our community. Please keep an eye on that, and clean up any grass growing into the street.

Once again I am going to state that county code requires house numbers posted near the front entrance, and they need to be at least 3 inches high to be clearly visible from the street.

This puts many of them at risk of losing their homes and their right to live in the community that they call home.

We urge you to take immediate action towards addressing these issues and finding sustainable solutions that are affordable for our residents. Please help us in preserving our community at Gulf Harbors, a place where residents can live out their retirement years without facing financial burdens.



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


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The Boater's Corner By Captains Bruce and Wendy Longman

There is one thing every boat needs. Maintenance. Fortunately, routine maintenance and even small repairs aren't that tough. The first and simplest task is to wash your boat regularly. As we boat in saltwater, rinse your boat thoroughly with fresh water after every outing to remove salt residue. Use Salt-away or similar for heavy build up, especially on the engine.

A boat with a clean hull bottom is more fuel-efficient than a hull that's covered with algae or other aquatic scum. A dirty hull can easily add up to 30% of fuel cost. If your boat stays in the water at a floating dock then dive on it once a month to brush the bottom paint clean.

Boats need to have their oil changed. Four-stroke outboards, inboards and stern drive boats require regular oil changes, at least every 100 hours or once a year.

Fortunately, changing the oil in your boat's engine is quite easy—in most cases, easier than changing the oil in your car. First, start the engine to warm it up. Turn it off, drain the old oil, change the filter, and fill the engine with new oil. Depending on the engine you might need to purchase an oil pump to drain the oil through the dip stick. I use a Moeller vacuum pump for less than \$100.

Check the propeller regularly. Make sure the propeller nut is secure and the retaining clips or cotter pins are not worn out. Always carry a spare prop and tools to change it. Inspect it for nicks, dents and cracks. It's OK if your prop is missing paint, but send it out for repairs if you find any signs of impact. The smallest dent can cause your boat to lose 10% of performance and will burn more fuel than normal and will cause vibration that can damage the seals.

You should also remove the propeller several times during the year to make sure discarded fishing line hasn't become wrapped around the propeller shaft. If it has, be sure to check the oil in the lower unit for water as fishing line can tear up the seals.

Check the lower unit oil for water on a regular basis. If water is in the oil the lower unit will need to be resealed by a mechanic. If you run with water in the lower unit for any reasonable length of time you will lose the gears inside. Rebuilds are very expensive. You should change the lower unit oil once a year. It is very easy to do yourself with a cheap lower unit oil pump from West Marine.

Happy Labor day my friends! Why not switch up your burger this year and try my Greek inspired Burger.

- 1 ½ pounds ground beef 80/20
- 1 tablespoon Italian Seasoning
- 2 teaspoons rosemary finely chopped
- 1 teaspoon salt
- 1 teaspoon pepper
- 2 cloves garlic minced
- ½ cup mayonnaise
- 1/3 cup sundried tomatoes chopped fine
- 1 teaspoon lemon juice
- 4 thick slices Spanish onion
- 4 thick slices beefsteak tomatoes
- 16 basil leaves
- 1 cup Nikos Feta crumbled
- 4 whole wheat hamburger buns

Preheat the grill to 400 degrees

In a mixing bowl add the first 6 ingredients mix well and form into 4 equal size patties.

In a small bowl add mayonnaise, sundried tomatoes and lemon and set aside.

Spray grill with non-stick spray. Place patties on the grill close the lid and let burgers cook for 5 minutes. Flip burger patties add onion slices and tomato slices to the grill Close lid cook 4 minutes. Flip onion and tomato slices remove patties and let them rest loosely covered with foil also add buns sliced side down on grill and toast just until you have grill marks on the buns about 2 minutes remove tomato and onions slices as well as toasted buns.

To assemble the burgers place a burger patty on bottom bun tops with ¼ cup feta cheese, slice of grilled onion, grilled tomato spread about 1 ½ tablespoon mayonnaise mixture on the top bun place 4 basil leaves on mayonnaise mixture and place on burger, repeat for all.


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

Hello Gulf Harbors! Sales continue to be strong this summer and theoretically, would be even stronger if we had more inventory. We had more than one example lately of multiple offers on our listings, an example of how there can be more buyers for a certain type of home than there are homes available. The last multi-offer property we sold left 3 disappointed buyers on the curb wishing we had 3 more like it to sell! Overall, Gulf Harbors is on track to beat our 2022 year end sales. Last year at this time only 49 homes had sold and closed, this year we've sold 59 YTD, about a 20% increase in homes sold. As far as Supply and Demand, the monthly inventory is up to 2.7 months vs 1.8 months a year ago; yet 2.7 months is still a very strong sellers' market. As you know, in a sellers' market, the seller has more opportunity to control the price and terms of the sale. That's doesn't mean overpriced homes will sell, a house is worth what a buyer is willing to pay and what a seller is willing to accept and those factors have to line up to cause a successful sale. Our average price of home sold went down 25 % from \$787,000 to \$588,000, but that because the number of homes sold over \$1,000,000 changed dramatically; last year at this time 12 Million Dollar++ homes had already sold, this year – just 2! That doesn't mean home prices are declining, the average price per sq.ft. is just slightly below what it was last year. From what we experience with the demand for a recent home priced over \$1M, the buyers are out there looking, just waiting for the right house to come up! Thinking of selling? May be a great time to put your house on the market and make some buyers happy!
